Firefighter George continues his enthusiastic delivery in telling young children more information about the fire truck and fire safety. Here, children learn what is kept in the

side compartments. Words come across the video as a firefighter explains the different lights and air horn. Children will learn about the clothing and gear worn by a firefighter and will discover the difference between a fire engine and a ladder truck. They will see how a hydrant is opened and how the hose is connected. Maggie, a Dalmatian who helps the firefighters, adds interest to the this 38 minute VHS video. In lesson two, children will learn more about the compartments, and will see what firefighters do when they arrive at the scene of a fire. Children will be caught up in the excitement of this close-up view of a fire truck.
