Words come across the video screen as Firefighter George explains the different levers and gears they use in the cab. Children will learn the different names of the cars on a freight train, like Box Car and Tank Car. Children will learn about the difference between a freight train, a subway train, and a passenger train. They will see how the cars are coupled together and how a real train yard operates. And children will absolutely love watching the elephants, tigers, horses, and zebras loading in and out of the circus train. However, the most important aspect of this video is their dedication to teaching the top ten lessons on train safety to the children. We know of no other children's video that teaches like these two videos do. As parents and grandparents continue to be ever so careful about what they let their children watch, they will feel good about the way these safety lessons help prepare their children to make good decisions when put in difficult situations.
