Then they observe the operator in an electric transit vehicle — and learn to watch out for the third rail. The firefighters also take the kids for a visit to the Ringling Bros. and Barnum & Bailey Circus Train, and on an Amtrak train — including inside the kitchen. More than anything, the video teaches kids to expect the unexpected and stay a safe distance away.
